- **War grave** At the Hankaniemi cemetery (Kainuuntie 64)
- **Model of Kuhmo church village in 1939** (Kainuuntie 126),
buildings destroyed by airstrikes marked
- **Veterans' memorial** in 1994 (Koulukatu 1)
- **The old bridge of Tervasalmi** (Tuuliniementie) in 1935,
The Soviet patrol tried to destroy
- **Jämäs Barracks** (Kurikkaniementie 11)
Barracks of the Border Guard 1937–2000
Remote Scout department **Marttina monument** in the yard
- **Jämäs School** (Autiontie 20),
During the winter war, a military hospital, privately owned
- **Jyrkänkoski military base** (Nurmestie 929),
Winter War demonstration area maintained by Kuhmo
reserve officers
- **Winter War Battlefields**
In the eastern part of Kuhmo, along Nurmestie, Lieksantie,
Saunajärventie, Vetkontie and Hukkajärventie.
Battlefields, monuments, stone barriers, restored trenches
